Procedural Manual Changes:

Problem with current policy: There is no statement found in the procedural manual stating that all students must be accompanied by an advisor/adult at every event

Suggestion for change: Add an item #12 which states: All students must be accompanied by an advisor/adult that is the age of 21 or over that will be responsible for them at every event sponsored by KS FCCLA

Motion: Bree Dowd moved to accept procedural change #1, with the added change of age Seconded: Kacey Voted: Adopted

Problem with current policy: Nothing is state in the procedural manual.

Suggestion for change: All district officers must be a member of an active chapter in the assigned FCCLA district. Active is interpreted as having a currently employed FACS teacher be the FCCLA advisor and national, state and district dues have been paid.

Motion: Raimie moved to accept procedural change #2 Seconded: Bree Vote: Passed

Problem with current policy: Policy states the state advisor shall register all KS participants, however due to varying arrival of delegates and increased registration times; it seems a better directive for local chapters to register themselves once at the conference.

Suggested Policy Now: "E. It will be the responsibility of the chapter advisor, or assigned sponsor to register online and to pick up individual registration packets at National Leadership Conference.

Motion: Bree moved to accept procedural manual change #3

Seconded: Megan Voted: Passed

Problem with Current Policy: The state advisor has been responsible for overseeing check in at the NLC lodging location. This creates problems with early arrivals and those who cannot arrive at the lodging location during identified check in times.

Suggested policy: "D. The state advisor will make NLC sleeping room and duty assignments as well as arrange for the official lodging reservations, chapters will still make payments to state office(Kansas FCCLA) for lodging, however it will be the responsibility of the chapter advisor, or assigned chapter sponsor to actually check in all delegates associated with their school group.
