- Scholarship recipients may reapply for scholarship.
- May attend any four-year college or university in Kansas with a FCS Education Program.
- Two (2) \$750 stipends may be awarded.
- Stipends will be paid directly to the recipient.
- Applications must be sent to Kansas FCCLA Educational Foundation.
- Recipients will be announced at the annual State Leadership Conference.
