2. How did you determine what project you would do?
3. How are other members involved or informed about this project throughout the year?
4. State the goals of this project.
5. How would you follow up on this project/program of work?
6. What are your plans for the future and how will this experience help you?
7. How was the planning process used during the project?
8. How did you increase public awareness of FCCLA?
9. What image of FCCLA did you convey because of this project?
10. How have your Family and Consumer Sciences classes helped you to prepare for this area/project/job? How does this area/project/job relate to Family and Consumer Sciences? What Family and Consumer Sciences skills were/are used in this area/project/job?
11. How much time are you prepared to devote to this job per week?
12. Describe a difficult situation you have been in and how you handled it. (or the judge may give a situation)
13. How did you get interested in this type of job?
14. Why do you think you are best suited for this job?
15. What are some of the reactions of the children/families/community members to your project?
16. What groups were targeted in your project(s)? Why were these groups selected?
17. How was information presented to the target group? What forms of media are available in your community? What media forms were utilized?
18. What other extra-curricular activities have you been involved in?
19. What skills do you believe you have strengthened because of your involvement in this STAR Event?
20. What advice would you give to other students interested in completing a similar project?
